PROCEEDINGS OF THE 10TH GOVERNING BODY MEETING OF GOVT. POLYTECHNIC, NAYAGARH HELD ON DATED 26.10.2021 AT CONFERENCE HALL OF COLLECTORATE, NAYAGARH UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE COLLECTOR & DISTRICT MAGISTRATE, NAYAGARH.

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The 10th Governing Body Meeting under the Chairmanship of Dr. Poma Tudu, IAS, Collector & District Magistrate—cum —Chairman of this Institute was convened on 26th October 2021 at 11:00 A.M in the Conference Hall of Collectorate, Nayagarh. The following members were present in the meeting, whose signatures were appended in the Attendance register.

At the outset, the Principal, G.P, Nayagarh and Member Secretary welcomed all the members of the Committee and briefed various development of the Institution. Thereafter, with the kind permission of the Hon'ble Chairman discussions were made on different agenda points and decisions/instructions on various agenda points taken by the committee are depicted as follows.

- 1. The Proceedings of last Governing Body Meeting held on dated 28.12.2020 was approved.
- 2. The expenditure made from Development fund of P/L Account from 08.12.2019 to 25.10.2021 of Govt. Polytechnic, Nayagarh amounting of Rs. 3,47,964/- (Rupees three lakhs forty seven thousand nine hundred sixty four) only in Annexure I for various developmental activities was discussed by the members of the committee and approved by the committee.
- 3. The activities vis-a-vis Budgetary Provision from Nov 2021 to Apr 2022 of Govt. Polytechnic, Nayagarh amounting of Rs. 7, 05,000/- (Rupees seven lakhs five thousand) only in Annexure II was discussed by the members of the committee and approved by the committee. However Hon'ble Chairman has instructed to make expenditure keeping in view the total collection of development fees from the students in P/L account in a particular year. Further, it was also decided in the meeting to incur various expenditures on priority basis like Maintenance & repair of CCTV sysyem in classrooms, Laboratories, Common Spaces, Corridors, ladies hostel & gate, Diesel for DG set, Diesel for bus, Maintenance of 140 nos. Computers & periferals, Annual Maintenance of pumpsets in Administrative Building, Workshop, Academic Building, Canteen, Boys & Ladies hostels & DG set, Electrical Machine Maintenance of laboratory including wiring system of Academic Block, AMC of 5 nos. Aquaguard, Laboratory Maintenace & purchase of lubricants for machines & small tools, Hiring charges of vehicle for movement of Principal in official purpose purposes for six months, Raw material for various Labs, Sanitiser & related equipments for newly admitted



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students(COVID Care protection), Chemicals for Institution garden with equipments for sprinking to eradicate white ant & shrubs, Fuel for grass cutting machine, Wages for 03 nos. outsider sweeper for both hostels (Boys & Girls) & 01 no. of Lady Attendant.

4. The committee approved the hiring of vehicles for the Institution on daily basis as and when required instead of monthly basis to avoid early depletion of Development fund. The committee discussed the matter and allowed the use of hired vehicle as per the following rates.

Hiring charges of vehicle @ Rs. 1000/- per day with fuel consumption @10 KM/LTR.

Type of vehicle allowed:-Any vehicle available with the above price.

5. Post – repair of two hostels after closure of COVID Care Centre (Both 100 seated boys hostel & 200 seated Boys hostel):-

The extent of damaged due to conversion of both hostels into Covid Care Centre for Nayagarh District were placed before the committee. Principal apprised the committee that, due to heavy use of sanitiser/Sodium hypo chloride, all steel grills/surfaces of staircase/staircase steps were fully disfigured & corroded. Further, the standing urinals, comboards, latin pans & other sanitary fittings like water taps, bip cocks were fully damage during functioning of the Covid Care Centre. Some water closet in new hostel due to blockage by foreign materials are disfaunt. Hon'ble Chairman of G.B instructed to the Superintending Engineer, PWD, Nayagarh Division, Nayagarh to repair all defects of both hostels out of District Covid funds.

(Action: - Superintending Engineer, PWD (R&B), Nayagarh)

- 6. The Principal placed the requirement of sweeper & Lady Attendant to maintain & clean the vast infrastructure of this Institution having 2 lakhs sq. Ft. built up area which includes 100 seated Boys hostel, 200 seated Boys hostel, 100 seated Ladies hostel, Canteen, Guest House, Academic Building, Administrative Building, Workshop Building, internal road systems etc. The committee considered on the point & the Chairman allowed to engage the following personnels on daily wages basis.
 - (1) 01 no. sweeper for Ladies hostel,
 - (2) 01 no. Lady Attendant for Ladies Hostel &
 - (3) 02 nos. of sweepers for entire campus.

The wages of all above 04 nos. shall be incurred out of development fund of P/L account of this Institution & development fund of hostel.

- 7. The admission status of the academic session 2021-22 was discussed in the meeting. Principal appraised the current vacancy of this year. (Civil-57/60, Electrical-60/60 & Mechanical-60/60). Only 03 nos. of Civil Engg. seats lying vacant The committee discussed on the matter & the Chairman advised to make proper planning by involving the District Welfare Officer, Nayagarh to achieve Zero vacancy & in particular the intake percentage of girls student must be increased.
- 8. The placement details of the Institute were discussed in the meeting. Principal, Govt. Polytechnic, Nayagarh intimated that, due to COVID situation, the placement percentage is not encouraging & will take suitable measure to enhance more campus placement in next academic session.

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- 9. The benefit of various scholarships availed by the students of this Institution was discussed in the meeting & appreciated by all the members. Hon'ble Chairman proposed to encourage the girls students to avail thebenefits under various scholarship schemes. Further, Hon'ble Chairman instructed that, no girl child in the district is deprived of getting admission in Dilpma stream due to non deposit of admission fees. Hon'ble Chairman also instructed to Principal to bringthis matter to the kind notice of the District Administration for a solution.
- 10. The matter of **development of playground** of the institution was discussed before the committee & the Principal intimated that the Institution is constructed in low land by diverting a natural stream for which there is always seepage in the playground from the higher level, which makes the playground unfit for use by the students. The committee considered the importance of the playground for the students & the Hon'ble Chairman instructed the PWD (R&B), Nayagarh Division to frame the estimate & explore the provision of the funds at the earliest for the interest of the students out of District fund. (Action: PWD (R&B), Nayagarh Division, Nayagarh).
 - 11. Maintenance of the Building: The maintenance work of various building of G.P, Nayagarh undertaken by PWD (R&B) Nayagarh Division, Nayagarh since last one year was discussed in the meeting & all estemed members expressed satisfaction on the quality of execution of work by the PWD (R&B) Division, Nayagarh. The Chairman of the committee advised to take up of the repair work on priority basis out of District fund as budgetary provision of this Institution is meagre & not sufficient. The Superintending Engineer, PWD(R&B) Division has assured to take up of the maintenance work of the buildings on priority basis in a phased manner.

(Action: - PWD (R&B), Nayagarh Division, Nayagarh).

12. Maintenance of 02 nos. transformer was installed in the Institution alongwith power cut was discussed in the meeting. Due to frequent power cut in the Institution, the various state level examination/Dist level examination were affected seriously & need attention immediately. Hon'ble Chairman instructed the Executive Engineer, TPCODL to take immediate action on the score.

(Action: - Executive Engineer, TPCODL, Nayagarh Division, Nayagarh).

- 13. Digging of Bore-well in the Hostel: The non-availability of water for the hostel boarders during power cut period was discussed in the meeting & the SDO, RWSS is present in the meeting assured to dig a deep bore well in the hostel for daily needs of the boarders.

 (Action: Executive Engineer, RWSS, Nayagarh Division, Nayagarh).
- 14. Hon'ble Chairman approved the requirement of Part Time Guest Faculty (PTGF) of this Institution in the Notesheet Page No. 19 dated 01.10.21 in the PTGF file. & instructed Principal to give some responsibility to the Part Time Guest Faculty (PTGF) like student discipline, career counseling etc. & Hon'ble Chairman also emphasized the presence of all Part Time Guest Faculty (PTGF) in the Institution from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

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15. Principal GP Nayagarh intimated to the committee that, the Internal Revenue Generation Scheme (IRG Scheme) has been implemented in the Institution in which more than seven lakh rupees has been collected from various departments of East Coast Railway, Bhubaneswar and R&B Division, Nayagarh, RWSS, Nayagarh etc. by way of testing and certification of engineering materials supplied by them for self-sustainability of the Institution. The committee appreciated the move and chairman of the committee approved the expenditure towards repair and maintenance of various machine and equipment utilised out of fund collected under IRG programme.

Since there is no other issue, the meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
