Sub: Incorporation of a Rule-22(VII) under Rule-22 in the SCTE&VT Examination Rules for imposition of penalty for conduct of re-examination in case negative observation by flying squad team and amendment of examination Rule 8.2 and 10.2 of SCTE&VT amendment Rule, 2021.

Sir,

In inviting a reference to your letter No.79 dated 06.01.2026 on the above noted subject, I am directed to say that, Government after careful consideration have been pleased to approve the amendment of SCTE&VT Examination (Amendment) Rule, 2021 as follows:

**SCTE&VT Examination (Amendment) Rules, 2026**

2. The Rule 8.2 in the original rule shall be substituted, namely:-

Any temporary physical disability, which existed during course of study shall be considered as valid reason for permitting a writer, if the examinee will submit medical certificate from a medical Officer of Odisha Government Hospital / Dispensary / CHC.

3. The Rule 10.2 in the original rule shall be substituted, namely:-

- i) 100% mark in 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Sem of the marks obtained by the candidate in 3 years courses.
- ii) 50% of the marks obtained by the candidate in the 1<sup>st</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup> semesters and 100% marks of the rest semesters for 4 years (Part time) courses
- iii) 100% marks of all the semesters for 2 years courses

The determination of division shall be as follows:

- a) 70% or above: 1st Division with Honours (Subject to the condition the candidate has passed all the semester end examination in one chance)
  - b) 60% or above : 1st Division  
(those who have not awarded 1st division with Honours)
  - c) 50% or above but less than 60%: 2nd Division
  - d) 40% or above but less than 50%: - Pass
  - e) Lateral entry students : Division to be awarded considering the mark secured in 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> semester & Rule 5.2
  - f) Less than 40%: Fail
- iv) for examination conducted as per the rules and regulations of other Statutory/National bodies, the pass marks and division shall be as per the rules and regulations of those bodies.
4. The Rule 22(VII) is to be inserted in the original Rule, namely :-

If any negative observation is reported by the flying squad team against any institution during the semester examination, re-examination of that subject for which negative report has been received from flying squad shall be conducted at nearest Govt. Polytechnics/Institutions as decided by the SCTE&VT, Odisha. The penalty for conduct of this re-examination is fixed as Rs.50,000/- with form fill up fee of all students @ Rs-1100/- per student. This entire amount shall be borne by the institution and no amount shall be collected from any student.
